

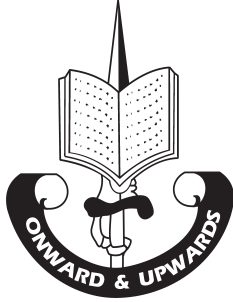

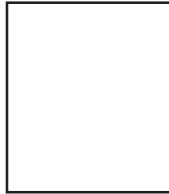

ABOUT THE SCHOOL

The school was founded in 1981 under the patronage of the Bishop of Cochin Rt. Rev. Dr. Joseph Kureethara with Very Rev. Msgr. Paul Katticherry as the School Manager and Mrs. Patsy De Rosario as the Headmistress. In 1983 Rev. Dr. Francis M.J. Fernandez took over as the new Manager and during his time the school blossomed from Lower Primary to Upper Primary with the Recognition of the Govt. of Kerala.

After the demise of Rt. Rev. Dr. Joseph Kureethara in the year 2000, the new Bishop Rt. Rev. Dr. John Thattumkal became the Patron of the school. In the year 2001 Rev. Dr. Joseph Kandanattuthara took charge as Manager of the school and Rev. Sr. Celestine D'souza was the Principal. In 2002 C.B.S.E. Syllabus was introduced.

In January 2006, Rev. Fr. Jiju Kochukariyil took over St. Paul's Public School and under his managership the school began to take a new shape and structure. Well-equipped labs for Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Maths and Computer were set up. In April 2006 Mr. Augustine Jerome Manakkatt was appointed as Principal. In November 2006 the school was upgraded to Senior Secondary level. Plus-one batches in Science I, Science II and Commerce started in the academic year 2007 - '08.

On the resignation of Rev. Dr John Thattumkal, Most Rev. Dr. Daniel Acharuparambil became the Apostolic Administrator of Cochin Diocese. In July 2009 Rev. Dr. Joseph Kariyil took the office of the Bishop of Cochin Diocese and took charge as the Parton of St. Paul's Public School. After the retirement of Mr. Augustine Jerome in March 2012, Prof. Robert Stanley took charge as the Principal from June 2012. In January 2016, Rev. Fr. Antony Kuzhivelil took over as the new manager. In June 2017 Rev. Dr. Grimbald Lanthaparambil took charge as Manager of the school. In July 2022 Dr Sheena George was appointed as the Principal of the school.

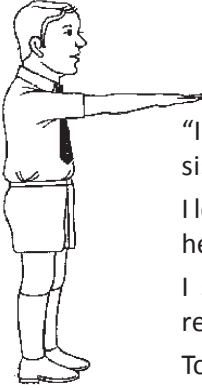

ADMISSION AND REMOVAL

- (i) The Management reserves to itself the right to give or deny admission to any child.
- (ii) Parents seeking admission for their children in this school, shall fill up the prescribed application form and submit the same to the Principal. Direct brothers or sisters of students of this School can register the names for LKG in advance (August).
- (iii) Children suffering from any contagious or infectious disease will not be admitted.
- (iv) False representation of any kind, for the purpose of obtaining admission is a sufficient reason for the dismissal of the candidate from the school.
- (v) For admission, the children shall be accompanied by the parents/guardian, who shall produce certificate of Date of Birth, obtained from the Corporation / Municipality / Panchayat.
- (vi) The students seeking admission to higher classes shall appear for an entrance examination and if admitted they shall produce a valid Transfer Certificate from the school they previously attended.
- (vii) An undertaking in the prescribed form to the effect that the parent / guardian shall strictly abide by the rules and regulations of the school shall be signed by the parent.

- (viii) A student who comes with a failed certificate from another school shall not be eligible for admission to any class.
- (ix) A pupil shall have his / her name removed from the rolls :
- (a) If he/she is absent without leave for 5 consecutive working days from the date of reopening of the school in the new academic year,
 - (b) If he/she is absent without leave for 15 consecutive working days, at any time during the academic year,
 - (c) If he/she fails twice in any of the standards,
 - (d) And if the parent / guardian does not comply with the request of the principal to withdraw the student from the school.
- (x) Mobile phones are strictly banned in the school campus. In the event of any violation of the above rule, the principal or the teacher is empowered to seize the phone and to impose appropriate punishment.

PLUS TWO COURSE

Admission to class XI will be based on merit. Though there is no Board Examination at the end of first year, internal examination will be conducted by the School.

Promotion will be based on the average marks of 1st, 2nd and 3rd Terminal Examinations. As per CBSE norms a candidate shall obtain 33% marks in all the subjects in order to be declared as having passed class XI Examination. Pass mark in each subject will be 33%.

Any relaxation to the rule is purely at the discretion of the Management and the Management shall have the full right for the promotion or detention of the candidates.

FEES

Admission fee, special fee and the first instalment of tuition fee shall be paid at the time of admission.

Monthly tuition fee is to be paid online in four equal instalments. The students shall pay the first instalment on the first week of June. The second, third and fourth instalments shall be paid on the first week of September, November and February respectively.

A student whose name is on the rolls can pay the fees for the whole year at one instance.

A student who leaves the school without paying the fees will not be given any certificate from the school until the arrears are paid.

Whenever the fee is paid, a formal receipt, signed by the authorised person shall be obtained.

The fee once paid, will not be refunded on any account.

Fifteen days after the last date for payment an official reminder notice will be sent from school. Second reminder will be sent after another fifteen days and a third reminder after the next fifteen days. If dues are not paid within this time the name of the student will be removed from the rolls without any further information. Thereafter a readmission may be taken if so desired, after settling the dues.

Fee payment can be done at any South Indian Bank Branch through online or mobile banking. Google pay also accepted.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

- (i) The parents are under obligation to co-operate with the Management and the school authorities for the discipline of the school.
- (ii) The parents should take care in sending the children to school regularly and in time, neat and clean in person and dress and in their school uniform.
- (iii) The morning session begins with the school assembly which should be attended by all children and the members of the staff.
- (iv) Inattentiveness or indifference towards any subject, disrespect and discourtesy towards the staff or any act which affect the discipline of the school will be dealt with seriousness.
- (v) Irregular attendance, habitual negligence in studies, dishonesty, use of obscene words or other acts of misconduct will involve severe disciplinary action.
- (vi) Every student will handle with care the school property and shall co-operate in maintaining the cleanliness and tidiness of the building and furniture. Any damage done to the school property or to other students will have to be made good.
- (vii) Except on fee dates the main gate of the school will remain locked during the class hours. Any urgent message has to be conveyed to the students through the principal by contacting over the phone 2217276.
- (viii) Withdrawal of children from class during the school time is not permitted. Parents who want to take their children to hospital are advised not to send the children to school for a session.
- (ix) The parents are not allowed to meet the teachers during class hours. Parent wishing to meet the class teachers may do so in the staff room only by previous appointment through the principal.

- (x) The parents should inspect the books every day and sign the remarks and help the children to do their homework.
- (xi) No student is expected to indulge in any form of ragging, if found so, strict action will be taken against such erring students as per the Ragging Act implemented by the State of Kerala.

GENERAL RULES

- The school hours are from 8.00 to 1.35pm.
- The student shall reach the school at 7.45 am.
- Students shall bring their school diary and ID card every day.
- Those who are on leave must fill the record of leave in the diary.
- Students are strongly encouraged to speak English in the school campus.
- Students are expected to greet the staff when they see them the first time during the day.
- The students shall be responsible for the safe custody of their belongings. It is advisable to have the names inscribed on articles like water bottle, tiffin carrier, umbrella, school bag etc.
- Students are not to wear gold ornaments or other valuable articles to school. Students upto std 8 are not allowed to wear watches.
- The boys should come to school with their hair neatly trimmed. Long hair, pony tail, spiked and styled hair, colouring of hair and shaving of head are strictly forbidden.
- It is suggested that girls with more than shoulder length hair must tie it up with blue ribbon on top and blue hairband below in plaits on two sides. Wearing of mehndi, tattoo, colouring

of hair and nails, using of liquid eyeliner on the eyelids is strictly prohibited.

- Bring textbooks and notebooks according to the daily timetable.
- No student may leave the school premises during school hours without the authorisation from the principal.
- Fans and lights should be switched off when the students go out of the class.
- Before the commencement of the assembly playing on the ground, class rooms and verandas is not allowed.

LIBRARY RULES

- All members of the staff and students are members of the school library.
- Strict silence should be observed in the library.
- No damage shall be caused to the library books. If a book is lost or damaged, it shall be replaced or its value and fine paid by the student who is liable.
- TC will not be issued if there is any library book to be returned.

SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

The school provides ample opportunities for co and extracurricular activities besides academic coaching. Cultural activities, S.U.P.W, Sports and games are given due importance as they assist the all-round development of children. Students take part in the following games - Football, Volleyball, Basketball and Badminton. Coaching sessions are also organized for various games under the supervision of qualified coaches. Besides interhouse competitions the school teams participate in interschool matches also. Tours and excursions are arranged every year to provide outdoor experience to children.

HOUSE SYSTEM

Students are trained to hold positions of responsibility. There are school appointments, class appointments, house appointments etc. The class monitor performs duties assigned to him/her by the class teacher. The Head Boy, Head Girl, House Captains and other prefects appointed by the Principal from amongst those who show qualities of leadership, form a very valuable group of the school community. The entire school is divided into four houses. At the head of every house are house captains. A member of the staff assisted by two other teachers acts as the House Warden. They look after the general progress of their wards in academics, games, and sports, co-curricular activities etc. All competitions are held on inter house basis.
